STEWARDSHIP

Douglas-Fir Beetle

12 Douglas-fir beetle funnel traps were installed at four locations on the community forest to monitor and control beetle populations

Bats

Bat protection screens were installed in all beetle funnel traps to prevent incidental bat capture

WILDFIRE RISK REDUCTION

NACFOR completed fuel treatment on three units and developed one treatment prescription in 2021. The main goals are to decrease fuels and increase tree separation to mitigate the risk of wildfire and create a fuel break around the Village of Nakusp.

Tenure Capacity Building Project:

Small tenure holders can look forward to a new initiative to build capacity in optimizing log product value, utilizing and minimizing waste, and increasing harvesting efficiency. This initiative is made possible through seed funding from NACFOR, and additional funding from the Wood Product Development Council (WPDC), and RDCK. A key part is building a regional network of participants to facilitate collaboration.

RECREATION

7km of NACFOR trails maintained at Arrow Park, Galena Bay, & Wensley Creek.

Larger parking lot developed at Wensley Creek Trails to facilitate educational partnerships.

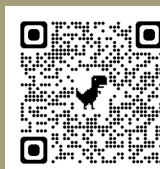

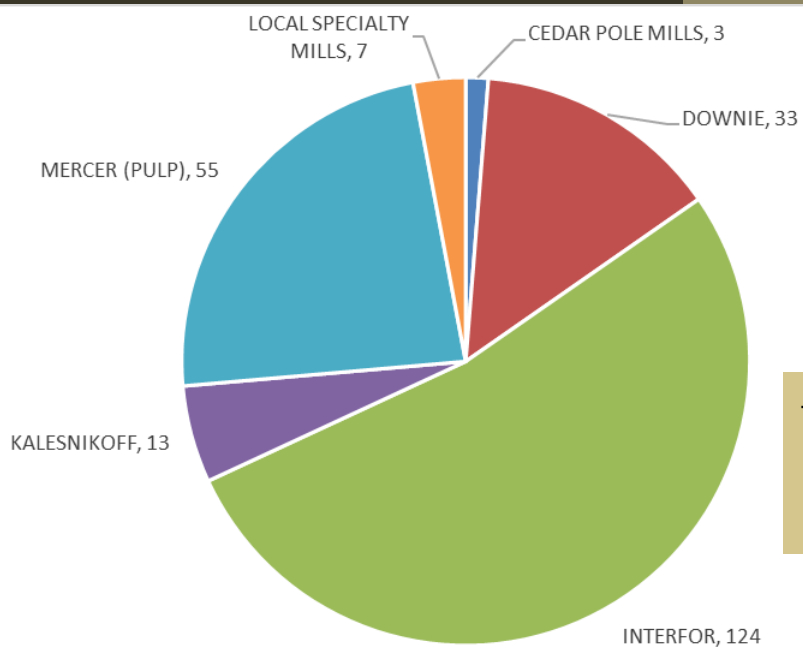

- Cedar Bark collection with NES

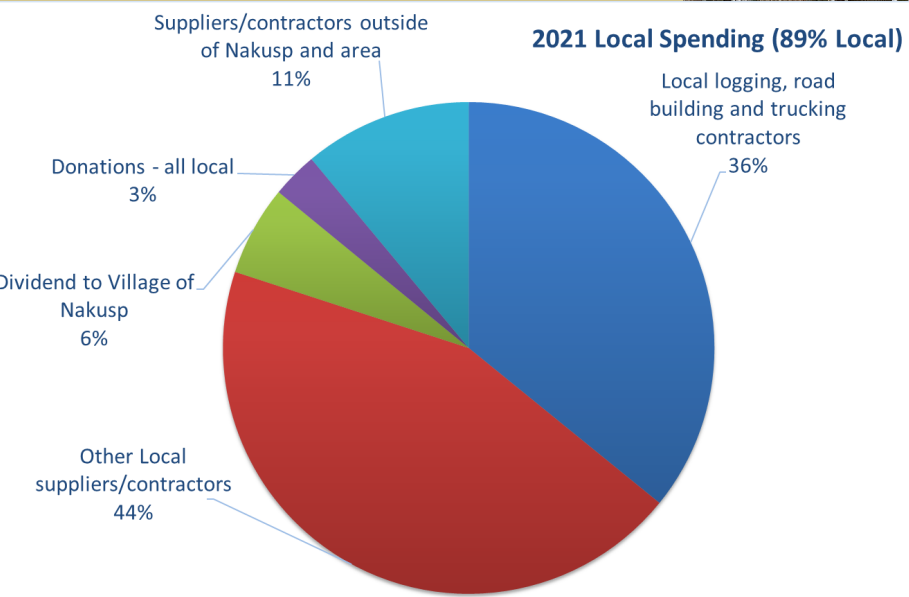
