

WILDFIRE RISK REDUCTION

NACFOR continued to implement treatment prescriptions on three units in 2022. The main goals are to decrease fuels and increase tree separation to mitigate the risk of wildfire and create a fuel break around the Village of Nakusp.



EDUCATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS


NACFOR regularly partners with SD #10 for educational purposes. Field trips in 2022 with NACFOR included:
