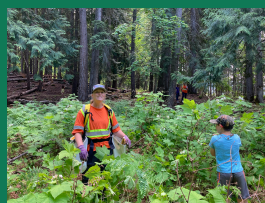
STEWARDSHIP

Douglas-Fir Beetle

12 Douglas-fir beetle funnel traps were installed at four locations on the community forest to monitor and control beetle population. Selective timber salvage from trees affected by Douglas-fir beetle were logged in Wensley Creek.

Migratory Birds

Continued to implement best management practices for breeding migratory birds and active nests during operations.



EDUCATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS

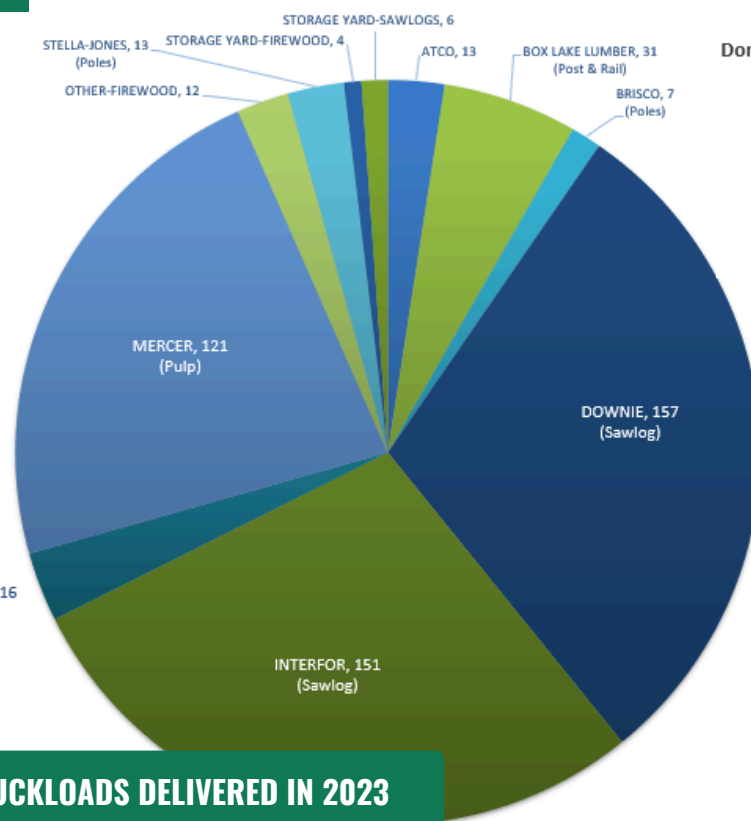
Tree Planting & Hiking

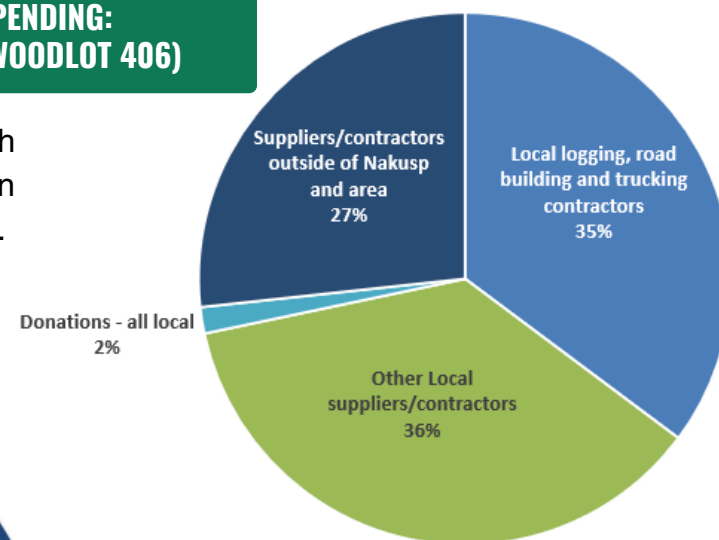
EDUCATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS

WILDFIRE RISK REDUCTION

NACFOR completed fuel treatment on four units in 2023. The main goals are to decrease fuels and increase tree separation to mitigate the risk of wildfire and create a fuel break around the Village of Nakusp.
